Primary Phase Clock Management

10-minutes 20-minutes 30-minutes 40-minutes 50-minutes 60-minutes

13 Fireground Indiscretions

- Lack of knowledge & Information
- Problems not identified & listed
- Inappropriate Operational Mode
- No IAP documented or communicated
- Insufficient personnel
- Officers operating at Task Level
- Tactical Accountability not maintained
- Nobody factoring 10-minute clock
- Random undisciplined communications
- Poor fire growth management
- Insufficient gpm for Btu (or H₂O delayed)
- Span of Control out of control
- No periodic situation reassessment

Strategic Considerations

- ✓ No *Offensive* positions at a *Defensive* fire
- ✓ Freelancing = No tactical accountability

Horizontal Ventilation

- ✓ No random acts of tactical violence (windows)
- ✓ Extreme caution when personnel inside

Positive Pressure Ventilation

- ✓ Establish exhaust opening before pressure
- ✓ Pressurize before personnel enter (never after)
- ✓ No personnel between blower and opening
- ✓ Corridors / hallways not obstructed by FFs

Coordinated Offensive Transition

- ✓ Water Supply Established
- ✓ Effective Ventilation
- ✓ Standby Team Deployed
- ✓ Confine & Extinguish Team Ready
- ✓ Incident Commander at Command Post
