- Any Glasgow Coma Scale other the 4/5/6 shall be treated with O₂, IV, and transported to a hospital for further medical evaluation
- Any heart rate > 150 at any time, or > 140 after cool down shall be treated and transported to hospital for further medical evaluation
Any initial heart rate > 120 shall be sent to Medical Evaluation / Treatment Area
Heart rate > 100 requires continued time in Rehab
- Any Diastolic BP > 200 mmHG at any time or > 130 mmHG after cool down shall be treated and transported to a hospital for further medical evaluation
Any Systolic BP > 160 mmHG or < 90 shall be sent to Medical Evaluation / Treatment Area
Any Diastolic BP > 110 shall be sent to Medical Evaluation / Treatment Area
- Temperature of > 101 after cool down shall be administered O₂, IV fluids, and transported to hospital for further medical evaluation
Temperature of > 100.6 shall not be permitted to return to active duty or wear SCBA
- Any complaints of shortness of breath, chest pain, altered mental status, abnormal lung sounds or EKG findings shall be provided ALS care and transported to a hospital for further medical evaluation
Any injuries shall be sent to Medical Evaluation / Treatment – Appropriate care shall be provided and transport to a hospital if indicated
