

R.I.T. Controller Checklist

- R.I.T. Controller reports to Rescue Group / Division Supervisor
- Obtain R.I.T. Team Readiness board at point of R.I.T. entry
- Document all personnel entering building or Hazardous Area
- Ensure that all companies are on the correct Rescue frequency
- Perform an air check on all entrants, ensure bottles are full, and document pressures of air cylinders
- Perform a rapid safety check of all entrants, ensuring that all PPE is being properly utilized
- Document the assignment or tasks given to entry units
- Document the time that each crew enters building or hazardous area
- Document what tools and equipment were taken into hazardous area by each crew
- Determine maximum interior time allowed (determined by Rescue Group/ Division Supervisor)
- Ensure that crews begin to exit the building with sufficient time and air for safe egress
- Closely monitor all traffic on designated Rescue frequency
- Document times that crews exit building
- Obtain information regarding tasks accomplished, findings, and other pertinent information as crews exit building
- Keep Rescue Group / Division Leader advised of entry units status, accomplishments, and findings
